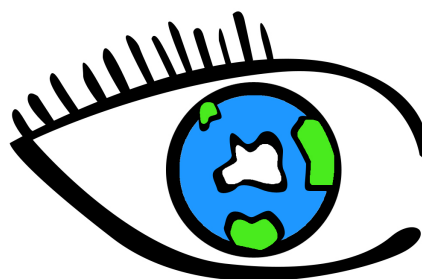

What is global citizenship?

Global knowledge, sensitivity to & respect for other cultures, active involvement in addressing issues of human and environmental sustainability.

Global citizenship in schools brings together 3 areas: Education for citizenship, international education, sustainable development education.

Education for citizenship involves an understanding of fairness and justice, making informed decisions, taking thoughtful & responsible action, locally & globally.

International education helps to prepare young people for life and active participation in an ever changing multicultural society.

Sustainable development is educating pupils about the environment, developing the knowledge & skills required to satisfy their basic needs, improving their quality of life
