CLASS CHARTS – Award Winning software to help celebrate achievement and monitor behaviour

I'm delighted to be writing to you about something that isn't Covid related.

From today, we are re-launching the use of Class Charts which is an award-winning software programme designed to help the school celebrate the achievement of its pupils and keep parents/carers informed.

Our focus will be on recognising positive (**over and above**) behaviours. These are detailed below.

1. **Achievement** – where a pupil succeeds with effort, skill or courage.
2. **Resilience** – where a pupil demonstrates grit and determination in class to succeed.
3. **Contribution** – where a pupil plays their part in bringing about a positive outcome for themselves or others.

A focus on **over and above** behaviours gives our pupils something more than the bare minimum to achieve.

As a parent you can track the progress of you children by accessing Class Charts on-line at www.classcharts.com and/or by downloading the app.

The first time you log in please input your code, one per child (provided by the school). You'll then be asked to create a password for access.

Parents of S1 Pupils - You will be issued a slip with the code you will need to input. Once you have done this, input a password and you will be able to access the features available.

Parents of S2-6 Pupils - You should be able to access Class Charts from the information sent last session. However, if you did not register please contact the school office and information will be provided.
